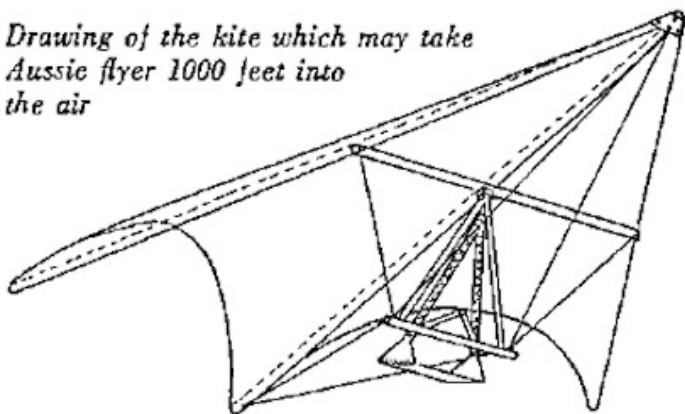


*Drawing of the kite which may take

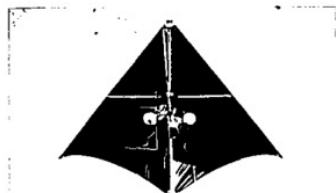
