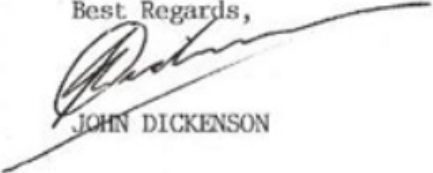
Please find in the following pages (total transmitted = 9) additional data for your files and interest.
