We, Gertrude Sugden Rogallo and Francis Melvin Rogallo, being duly sworn, depose and say that we are the applicants in the above-identified application; that the earliest facts or acts susceptible of proof, upon which we rely to establish conception of invention defined in claims 4 and 5 of such application for the purpose of establishing priority of invention, are as follows:

We experimented with the flying of kites substantially of the type set forth in claims 4 and 5 sometime in the summer of 1948. At that time it was decided to file a patent application showing the two-lobed type of kite having a crevice substantially as shown in our Patent #2,546,078. However, our work on the kite as shown in the present patent application continued until we felt we had a suitable commercial structure, which was shown to various people in 1950 and in 1951 by way of inquiry as to production possibilities. One such person was Mr. Will Yolen and another such person was a Mr. Serio and his partner. These people were connected with the toy industry.

We have been consistently active and diligent in the further development of this kite and other kites, particularly as shown in the aforementioned application, and have been affiliated with the kite manufacturing

industry as manufacturers and inventors since 1948.
