INVENTION

Count 1

A kite comprising an airfoil member of flexible material capable of being arched by a supporting airstream and being shaped so as to effect a conical arch of the surface thereof

transversely across the airfoil member, the crest of said arch being the longitudinal axis of said airfoil member, and bridle strings attached to said airfoil member on opposite sides of the longitudinal axis serving to guide and control said kite and present the surface thereof at a suitable angle of attack.
